Description of Wooden Stave Pipe
through "Idlewilde", Land of Kalialinui, Maui.

Beginning at a point on the East boundary of "Idlewilde"
from which the South corner is by true azimuth and distance 331°
18' 231.3 feet and running by true azimuths:-

1. $17^{\circ} 56'$ 24.9 feet;
2. $59^{\circ} 57'$ 215.2 feet on a curve to the right;
3. $92^{\circ} 37'$ 167.1 feet to a point on the South boundary of the³
lot from which the South corner is by
true azimuth $279^{\circ} 38'$ 481.8 feet.
