Railroad Right-of-way (20 feet wide) thru Lot 47, Kapaa Homesteads, 1st. Series, Puna, Kauai, the center line of which is described as follows:-

Beginning on the boundary between Lots 47 and 48, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Northwest corner of Lot 48 and the Northeast corner of Lot 47 being, $190^{\circ} 27' 485.2$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $55^{\circ} 35' 270.3$ feet to point of curve;
2. Thence along a curve to the right with a radius of 716.78 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $61^{\circ} 12' 140.3$ feet;
3. $66^{\circ} 49' 329.5$ feet to the boundary between Lots 46 and 47, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Southeast corner of Lot 46, the Southwest corner of Lot 47, and on the North side of Kahuna Road being: $8^{\circ} 14' 491.9$ feet.
